**“The Clinic at Walmart” Operated by Primary Health Medical Group
to Open on November 17th**

Primary Health Medical Group’s first in-store clinic in an Idaho Walmart Supercenter; Clinic to bring affordable health care to thousands of Treasure Valley-area residents
